



ADDENDUM NO. 1

AIRPORT PARKING LOT PERIMETER FENCE

TO: All prime Contractors and all others to whom specifications have been issued.

ITEM 1.01 Questions and Responses, received by the deadline on September 18, 2024:

Question 1: The project manual (GC-7.02) states permits issued by the County will be at no charge but "The Contractor will be responsible for securing and paying for all other permits, governmental fees, landfill fees and licenses necessary for the proper execution and completion of the Work." Could you please identify what permits, other than the Counties, will be required?

Response: We are not aware of other permits required but the contractor is responsible for securing and paying for all other permits as specified. Washington County does not require building permits for fences that are not over seven feet high.

Question 2 Will the airport mark all private, underground utilities not identified by PA-1 call?

Response: The successful bidder/contractor is responsible for marking all public and private underground utilities in the vicinity of the proposed fence installation.

Question 3: Can the soil generated from fence post excavations be disposed of on-site or must they be removed?

Response: Soil generated from fence excavations shall be removed from the site by the contractor.

Question 4: Are prevailing wages required to be paid to workers? If so, will the county be providing prevailing wage rates?

Response: This project is not required to comply with prevailing wage rates.
