Summary of LEO Discussion:

<u>ACC Discussion</u>: Scott Matheny, Chair for the ACC, asked if it was possible to give time stamps on bodycam footage so they know where to focus. Also, he addressed all the departments on making sure their officers were aware of their language when being recorded. He also asked if when the officers are removing items from the people they have arrested if they can say exactly

what items are removed from what pocket if it is safe to do so.
